
WITNESSES OF PREHISTORY AT AIGUAFREDA

FREDA

La Serra de l'Arca (878 m) is a mountain range between the neighbouring towns of Aiguafreda and El Brull. "Arca" is for *arques*, the megalithic constructions which can be found in that area. The existence of prehistoric burial sites in the mountainous area of El Montseny has been known since the 19th century. The dolmens at Serra de l'Arca were discovered and excavated for the first time between 1924-1932 either by the priest Fortià Solà or the priest Josep Gudiol (Centre Excursionista de Vic). Most of the findings can be seen at the Museu Episcopal de Vic (Vic).
